



The Veterans Council of Indian River County is a 501c3 collaboration of veteran organizations, non-veteran entities that actively support veterans, and individuals who contribute to the welfare of veterans. The Veterans Council of Indian River County serves as an umbrella over Indian River County veteran resources.







VCIRC History

The Veterans Council of Indian River County was established in 1987 with an initial focus on providing transportation for veterans to the West Palm Beach VA Hospital; and hosting Memorial Day and Veterans Day Ceremonies honoring Veterans. Over the last few years, the Council has grown to more than 25 veterans organizations, and over 45 non-veteran civic, government and business entities.

To support all Indian River County veterans and their families while raising awareness of veteran needs and their contributions to society.

To be recognized as the leading Indian River County Agency for Veterans Support.

VCIRC Programs



Transportation Services

Transporting hundreds of veterans and their aides monthly to medical appointments locally and to the West Palm Beach VA Hospital.



Upward American Veterans

Providing emergency basic living financial support to qualified honorably discharged US veterans and their families.



Veterans Helping Veterans

Providing basic home improvements for veterans who cannot afford or are physically unable to complete the work.



Veterans: Outreach & In the Classroom

Hosting veteran and family events. Teaching students about respect for the nation, flag honors, military service and citizenship.



Honoring Veterans

Honor Guards performing ceremonies for over 50 patriotic events and funerals annually along with Memorial and Veteran's Day ceremonies.



Scholarship Program

In partnership with Indian River State College, the Veterans Council provides scholarships for dependents of veterans.

Transportation Services

500 Veterans and their aides transported to the VA Hospital in West Palm Beach during the 2019/2020 fiscal year.



Upward American Veterans

UAV provided emergency financial assistance for basic living needs to **156** veterans and their families totaling **\$88,274**.



Veterans Helping Veterans

VHV provided **25** essential home improvement services to veterans and their families totaling **\$72,500**.



Veterans: Outreach & In the Classroom

Provided outreach to more than **400** Veterans at the Veterans and Family picnic. More than **3100** Indian River County students participated in this program in approximately 2.5 years.



Honoring Veterans


Provided more than **50** patriotic events and funerals along with Memorial and Veteran's Day ceremonies.

Harry served during WWII in the 92nd Division, "Buffalo Soldiers" that fought in France, Northern Italy and Belgium. His feet had been frozen and he still struggles to walk.

At 93-years-old and disabled, the WWII Veteran and his wife, Gladys, who is also disabled, had been struggling to take care of each other while living in a home with seriously unsafe conditions. Someone had graciously placed a blue tarp on

their roof after hurricane Irma and there it remained many months later. They had a broken window, a broken hot water heater which flooded the house, and they had to store their food with their neighbors because of a broken refrigerator.

Harry applied to Upward American Veterans program (UAV) for assistance to address the poor and unacceptable living conditions of his home. Upon inspection of the home, additional issues were uncovered.

Through the UAV program, with assistance from the Military Officers Association of America, essential repairs were made and appliances were replaced or fixed. The Lamb's living conditions became much better, especially with the donation of a new roof! When contractors were leaving, from his chair on the porch, Harry said, "now my Gladys is happy."
